**Category:** Programming Software

**Subject:** How to determine revision of Radio Personality Manager (RPM) Software that was used to program a radio.

**Summary:** The version of RPM used to read out a radio personality must be the same as or later than the last version used to program it. If an earlier version of RPM is used, the following error message will be displayed.




**Action:** As previously described in TSM#27-17, two methods are available to determine what version of programming software was used last:

Method 1: Using the radio menu, access "REVISION" with the menu button and look for "PERS VER". The number displayed indicates the revision of software used to program the radio. Numbers 50 and above indicate that RPM software was used. "PERS VER" **50.00** translates to RPM R01b, for example:

"PERS VER **50.00**" equals RPM revision **R01b01**, 51 equals **R02a05** and 52 equals **R03a08**.

Method 2: Using the Maintenance Utility function of RPM, query the radio with the RADIO INFORMATION command. In the read-only window displayed, a RPM SW Group value in HEX will be displayed. In the example below, a **Hex value 33** = **Decimal value 51**.

... Therefore **R02a05** of RPM was used to program this radio.
